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Francesco Miele is Researcher in the e-Health research unit of the Bruno Kessler Foundation of Trento. He is also member of Research Unit on Communication, Organizational Learning and Aesthetics of the University of Trento and is adjunct professor at University of Verona and at University of Trento. His recent research interests include the technology-mediated coordination of healthcare professionals and patient in telemonitoring, the workplace health promotion initiatives and the management of complex therapies in elderly patients. 
